A classic tasco serving Portuguese classics; feels like a secret spot, until the lines form.

Rosamar ♦

Chic and tucked away seafood restaurant; small portions with tropical accents.

Magnolia Bistrot ♦

Lovely, tiny brunch spot on a park corner.

Boubous ♦

Tucked away, this lively upscale dining spot serves up funky things like CBD granita.

Carnal

Eleven


Michelin starred venue in the park, one our clients rave about.





Bettina and Niccolo Corallo Chocolate Cafe ♦

For the best cup of hot chocolate you've ever had, sourced directly from a cacao plantation in São Tomé and Príncipe. Side note about hot chocolates in Portugal: you must order it "para beber" (to drink) vs. "para comer" (to eat - in which case, it will be served with a spoon and is much thicker!)

Zenith

For all day brunches and cocktails.

Comoba

A refreshing, intimate breakfast spot.

Bar Terraco de Santa Luzia

For great views.

Monkey Mash

Funky cocktail bar.

Red Frog

A cool speakeasy, just above the Monkey.

Manteigaria ♦

A favorite place to grab a classic Pasteis de Nata - Arguably better than the crowded namesake cafe in Belem (but we suggest comparing both to be sure ;-)! There are several locations, including Porto & Braga.

Fabrica Coffee Roasters

For an excellent cup of coffee, in various locations including the Botanical Gardens.

Neighbourhood

Run by Australians, you won't find a better Flat White or coffee elsewhere. Breakfast too.

À Brasileira

Classic Portuguese cafe for light bites.

SIPS

Torel Palace - Black Pavillion ♦

Classy hotel bar with excellent mixologists.

Pavilhão Chinês

An eclectic bar - almost a dive - but not quite.

Sidebar & Bar TR3S

If you're up for a gay evening: a bar in the center of it all, and an off-the-beaten-path bear bar.
